On behalf of the Brasfield & Gorrie team here at 1075 Peachtree Street, I would like to offer my thanks to your field team on their recent completion of the auger cast piles for our project. Your team worked diligently to complete the 1535 piles in 51 working days, far ahead of schedule. And most importantly, no piles had to be re-drilled, and the number of low cages or low piles was almost non-existent.

As you know, the jobsite consisted of four distinct working elevations, but the Berkel team was ever-willing to climb and descend ramps, and drill from tight spaces in order to facilitate our needs in bringing up the structure in a non-typical order. In addition, the second pile rig, led by Superintendent David Caudle, installed over 250 tension piles, each having a 2 ½" continuous threaded bar. Storing and installing these bars, many of which were over ninety feet long, while not impeding other work, was no small feat.

In closing, I want to congratulate the Berkel team for doing an exceptional job, and thank them for the long hours which have allowed us to complete the foundations well ahead of schedule. It would be a privilege to have this same crew on future projects. Attached is a partial list of the team members. I apologize for any names which may be omitted.
